Dear IPEC Federation members and friends, welcome to 2025's first issue of IPEC Federation Connect.



Strategic Focus and Priority objectives - 2025



At the IPEC Federation members' meeting held inperson on Tuesday 4 February 2024, accomplishments were reviewed to create a work plan for 2025. Built around the Federation's areas of strategic focus, several high priority objectives were identified for action.

Highlights include:

- Guidance and Regulation: Revision and creation of multiple IPEC Guides and positions, the completion of which will rely heavily on the participation of members for which we will be seeking volunteers soon. Equally, with the recent publication of excipient GMP requirements in China, a gap analysis with the 2022 IPEC-PQG Guide will be invaluable for all members involved in manufacturing and exporting materials there, to ensure compliance is maintained.
- Regulatory Convergence: while the Federation wishes to make its position on the importance of pharmacopoeial convergence publicly known, a topic of growing *divergence* seems to be how impurities in excipients are defined. There will be an opportunity to open discussion with PDG later this year for which we will prepare our case that this is indeed a matter of concern.



- Innovation: the way in which excipients are being used and how certain raw materials become *de facto* excipients in medicinal products is changing expectations of them. We need to consider if our guides and positions need repositioning to reflect user requirements.
- Stakeholder collaboration: working with WHO, particularly to enhance knowledge and education on measures to secure excipient supply chains, is a critical project to attack the recent increase in contamination incidents with tragic consequences.
- Monitor the environment with special attention to Microplastics, Nitrosamines, Nanoparticles (titanium dioxide), Talc and Sustainability topics. Increasingly, regulations are emerging from other industrial sectors which impact excipients, often significantly, to which we need to react to and inform our members of their responsibilities.
- ☑ Global expansion: The growing focus on excipients globally is stimulating interest in establishing new affiliate associations. The process developed will be piloted in Korea this year.
- Excipient education: A perceived lack of knowledge on excipients within various stakeholders identified this as a high priority, to develop basic excipient training, and particularly highlighting differences between API and excipients.

At its monthly meetings, IPEC Federation members monitor the **low** and **medium** priorities to see if activity is growing in any of these areas, and whether action is needed. IPEC Federation Annual General Assembly 2025 – Aix-en-Provence

The IPEC Federation organised its Annual General Assembly for 2025 in Aix-en-Provence, France on Tuesday 4 February.

Delegates from the five IPECs were present to discuss the results of activities in 2024 and to define the way forward for the association. During the Annual General Assembly, IPEC India was formally admitted as a full member of IPEC Federation.

The meeting was preceded by a members' meeting with updates from the different regions and a formal endorsement of the review of 2024 activities and priorities for the year(s) to come.



IPEC Quality-by-Design Guide – Free webinar for members

IPEC Federation announces the availability of the revised IPEC Incorporation of Pharmaceutical Excipients into Product Development using Quality-by-Design (QbD) (version 2).

The guide was first published as an IPEC Federation guide in 2020; however, with this revision, the guide has been updated to include an annex incorporating contents from the 2016 IPEC-Americas QbD Sampling Guide. The Guide is available now for all IPEC members, with a general release in May. Read more.

IPEC Europe Excipients Forum 2025 - 6 February, Aix-en-Provence, France

More than 120 attendees joined the yearly IPEC Europe Forum held in Aix-en-Provence on Thursday 6 February. Preceded by committee meetings and the Annual General Meeting of the association, IPEC Europe opened its Annual Forum with a welcome speech by Chair Amina Faham.

The theme "Navigating regulatory landscapes and emerging trends" covered several hot topics and with interesting exchanges between attendees and speakers. The morning session featured several regulatory topics, with presentations from the European Pharmacopoeia and WHO's position on the Global challenges and gaps in high-risk excipient supply chain. Representatives of ANSM (French National agency for Safety of Medicines) then provided a thorough overview of the inspections hold in France for excipient manufacturers.

A user-maker real-world on how to provide regulatory information for excipients closed the morning session. The afternoon opened with a panel session on the impact of artificial intelligence/machine learning and its application on excipient selection and formulation. Two presentations followed on the registration of complex raw materials, and microplastics and current challenges with biodegradability testing methods wrapping up the formal proceedings.

During the evening cocktail reception Frank Milek (former Chair of IPEC Europe and IPEC Federation) received an award for his outstanding contribution to the association.

Updates from IPEC China

In January 2025, China NMPA issued its Excipient and Packaging Material GMP as Annexes to GMP for drug products. The new GMP requirements will be mandatory and will need to be implemented by 1 January 2026.

IPEC China provided IPEC Federation members with a translation of the regulation; in parallel, IPEC China established a task force to perform a gap analysis on the requirements of the future China Excipient GMP vs. the IPEC-PQG GMP Guide.

IPEC China also organised two webinars on the topics of China Excipient GMP and ChP 2025 updates, held in January and February. 80 attendees joined the two sessions, respectively.


